## 15.6.2 Revision of fee structure for M.Tech Programmes.

During the Governing Council Meeting held on 9<sup>th</sup> May 2018 and the FC meeting of DIAT held on 18<sup>th</sup> May 2018, this issue was deliberated upon. There was a general opinion that the services to the stake holders should be charged at appropriate rates so that the grants-in-aid could be brought down. Also, it is inevitable that the fee structure has to be viable and should be able to absorb the inflationary trends over a period, if not an increase per se.
