Following reporting items presented by the Dean (Acad) with regard to enrollment of MTech courses of DIAT (DU) through CCMT (Centralized counseling for Master in Technology) for admission.

Dean (Acad) had informed that this time under the drop-down menu of the CCMT admission application the DIAT name also will be reflected as one of the institutes for admission. The admission will be done on the basis of GATE score in all NITs, IIITs, Central University and Centrally funded technical institutions etc. The eligibility criteria for all AICTE approved M Tech courses have been mapped as per the GATE subjects and loaded on the website of CCMT. Total 448 Nos of AICTE approved M Tech courses are available at CCMT platform for M.Tech.

Dean (Acad) informed that the NBA Self Assessment Report [SRA] for two M Tech courses i.e. Computer Science and Engineering and Electronic and Communications have been successfully submitted (online).

It is also reported that DIAT has successfully submitted its pending 5 years NAAC accreditation applications from 2015 to 2020 and will be submitting Self Assessment Report / Self Study Report before December-2021

# 24.5.1 Amendment to Rule 16 of Rules and Regulations Governing Service Conditions-2009

As per the Para 16 (3) (1) of the DIAT Rules and Regulations Governing Service Conditions, 2009, the Chairman, Governing Council (Secretary, DDR&D) is the Disciplinary Authority for imposing Major Penalties in respect of teaching and non-teaching officers of DIAT and the Vice Chancellor is the Disciplinary Authority for imposing Minor penalties only in respect of Teaching and non-teaching Officers of DIAT. The appointing authority for these staff is the Vice Chancellor. As per Gol rules, the Appointing Authority is the Disciplinary Authority. Hence, it is proposed to designate the appointing authorities as Disciplinary Authority for all the posts specified therein. Accordingly the disciplinary authorities as mentioned in Para 16 of the Rules & Regulations Governing Service Conditions needs to be amended as under:-

## 24.5.2 Approval of the M.Tech, PhD and MS (By Res) results of the Academic Year 2019 -21

Approval of the results of M.Tech 2019-21 batch, PhD and MS (By Research) Degrees by BoM was solicited.

#### Discussion:

- a. Prof. Prabhat Ranjan, VC, DY Patil University suggested that as per All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) all technical institutions approved by it should upload academic records on Digilocker, under the National Academic Depository (NAD). The initiative is aimed at preventing educational institutions from withholding certificates and academic records.
- b. Prof R K Shevgaonkar suggested that the results were reported in CGPA should be relative and not absolute though there are less number of students in the programme. Further, Prof. RKS also suggested that only relative grading, allows teachers to interpret the results of an assessment and determine grades based on student performance. DIAT should study the feasibility of implementing the relative grading option.

#### Decision:

The BoM has accorded approval of the M.Tech, PhD and MS (By Res) results of the Academic Year 2019 -21 presented by the CoE. The list of degrees awarded to students is attached as **Anneuxre-24.5.2** 

#### 23.5.3 Approval for establishment of three schools

DIAT has started the following Schools in three important domains for encouraging inter-disciplinary research and teaching:

- 1. School of Advanced Research in Robotics
- 2. School for Quantum Technology
- 3. School of Defence Technology

The opening of the above three schools were approved by the Academic Council meeting held on 18th June, 2020.

#### **Decision:**

The BoM after discussion and deliberations have accorded approval for the establishment of the above schools.

#### 24.5.4 Sanction of expenditure for purchase of scientific equipment:

As per the delegated financial powers recommended in 21st BOM dated 18/09/2020 and approved by the MOD vide their letter no: DHRD/70500/DIAT/DU/C/M/01, dated 07/10/2020, Vice Chancellor has power to sanction the expenditure for the purchase of scientific equipment up to Rs. 2.5 Crores on STE basis and Rs. 5 Crores for the purchase on PAC basis.

Following are the scientific equipment /consumables proposed to be purchased for the school of quantum technology on single tender basis.

Since the above procurement at an estimated cost of Rs. 4 Crores initiated on open tender has resulted into a single tender, which is beyond the powers of VC. The proposal is put up for approval of BOM

#### Discussion:

- a) It was mentioned that the indent was initiated on open tender, subsequently resulted in Single Tender.
- b) Dr. Kanaka Raju Pandiri from School of Quantum Technology has emphasized the importance of this optical components/sub-systems in realizing the quantum communication and quantum key distribution research program at DIAT.
- c) The Chairman has requested BOM to authorize the Vice Chancellor to procure the aforesaid scientific equipment on single tender basis for cost estimates of Rs. 4 Crores following PM-2016 procedure.
- d) Prof. R K Shevgaonkar suggested to follow DRDO/MoD delegation of financial powers pattern.

#### Decision:

After detailed discussions, the BOM decided to authorize the Vice Chancellor to procure the aforesaid scientific equipment on single tender basis subject to following the guidelines as laid down in DRDO PM 2016.

#### 23.6.1 Ratification of additional Budget Estimates DIAT for the FY 2021-22

Budget Estimates for the Financial Year 2021-22 of Rs.45.50 Cr. was presented before meeting of 24th Finance Committee Meeting held on 21st December 2020.Further to this additional funds to the extend of Rs.10 Cr was also asked for the new Centre/Schools.

In view of the urgency, Vice Chancellor Chairman BOM has given the approval for the said Budget of Rs.45.50 Cr and additional Rs.10 Cr for the new Centre / Schools.

Ratification of approval is sought for the Budget Estimate for the FY 2021-22.

#### Discussion:
