The Finance Committee in its 30th meeting held on 05/10/2023 considered the Budget Estimates of Rs.94.82 Cr for the F.Y. 2024-25 and recommended to modify the same to Rs. 72 Cr. approx, for the F.Y. 2024-25 for further examination. 33.5.3 Proposal to start MSc Tank Technology

Prof. Shaibal Banerjee, Director, School of Defence Technology and Chairman PGC, presented the proposal before the BoM to start M.Sc. programme in Tank Technology, jointly by DIAT and Armoured Corps Centre and School (ACC&S), Ahmednagar (An Indian Army unit). He stated that only Indian Army sponsored candidates from ACC&S will be eligible for admission in this specialized programme. He further stated that ACC&S has expertise and required infrastructural facilities to conduct a Master's programme in Tank Technology in association with DIAT. The Board of Studies for the above programme was held on 24-11-2023 to frame syllabus for this programme as per UGC norms. Thereafter, the above agenda was discussed and approved in Post graduate Committee on 06-12-2023. Subsequently, Academic Council in it's meeting held on 19-12-2023 has recommended to introduce M.Sc. program in Tank Technology at DIAT in association with ACC&S. The financial requirements for various academic activities such as conduct of lectures and study tours will be borne by ACC&S. Teaching will be done by faculty members of DIAT and Service Officers of ACC&S.

The Dean (Acad) apprised the BoM about the importance of this programme to Armed Forces. He mentioned that starting of such programmes is as per the mandate of DIAT towards imparting to armed forces and will also help in NAAC, NIRF assessments.

The eligibility criteria for admission to the above M.Sc. programme was deliberated in the meeting. It was noted that Officers from various graduation streams (such as Engineering/Technology/Science/Arts) who have undergone Technical Training only shall be sponsored by Indian Army for this programme.

The BoM appreciated the proposal and **RESOLVED** to introduce MSc in Tank Technology.
