- 4. **<u>Area of Specialisation</u>**: Skill in the domain of quantum Technology related areas viz Quantum Mechanics, Quantum Metrology etc.
- 5. **Essential Qualifications**: A Visiting Professors should be a Scholar of eminence in his/her field of Science/Technology/Management with a PhD degree from a UGC recognized University/Institution or Professional experience over 24 years having recognition at national/international level and having outstanding published work or A person of distinguished and long R&D experience in Labs or Nationally recognized institutes of Advanced Learning with Demonstrable background in Teaching can also be considered subject to approval by Vice Chancellor.
- 6. Age limit: Not exceeding 70 years.
- 7. The Visiting Professors are expected to actively participate in productive institutional activities, such as:
 - (a) Deliver formal lectures
 - (b) Engage in formal or informal discussions with postgraduate and research students
 - (c) Undertake collaborative research with faculty and PhD students
 - (d) Contribute to the university's teaching by presenting guest lectures or faculty seminars
 - (e) Present papers in university's seminar programs
 - (f) Be a co-guide to PhD students in addition to conducting their own research and publications.

8. OTHER GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SERVICE:

- (a) Period of Appointment could be for a period not exceeding 2 years extendable after review.
- (b) Shall be entitled to a fixed monthly remuneration, on a case to case basis, depending on the background and expertise, within the overall ceiling as decided by the BoM.
- (c) The remuneration payable shall be over and above the pensionary benefits, if any, to which they may be entitled to.
- (d) They shall be given duties as per their expertise and as may be considered appropriate by the Vice Chancellor. However, the incumbents are required to attend the Institute, for not less than 15 days a month (Calendar) and should be available during full working hours.
- (e) The engagement can be terminated by either side by giving one month notice.
- (f) They may be invited to a specific faculty meeting by the Vice Chancellor, but shall not have voting rights.
- (g) The travel costs of Visiting Professors shall be met from the regular Grants-in-aid budget.

9. **ENTITLEMENTS**:

- (a) Institute accommodation (married/single) subject to availability on payment of license fee
- (b) Appropriate office space and Lab facilities
- (c) Medical facility as available in the Institute.
- (d) TA/DA for movements within the country as applicable to a Asst professor of core faculty, for attending National/International seminars, Technical discussion, Project facility etc only if deputed by DIAT.
- (e) Faculty privileges with regard to access to library services, office space when campus, and IT access.
